Eligibility criteria for MSCA-IF researcher:

Experienced Researcher must be, at the date of the call deadline, in possession of a doctoral degree or have at least four years of full-time equivalent research experience.

Mobility rule: the researcher cannot have resided or carried out his/her main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the country of the beneficiary for more than 12 months in the three years immediately before the call deadline.

The **grant covers** living, mobility and family costs, as well research-related costs.

Project duration: 12-24 months for European fellowships and 24-36 months for Global fellowships.

About us

Liepaja University (LiepU) is a regional university with large experience and academic traditions. It was founded in 1954 on the basis of Teacher Training Institute. It is located in Kurzeme region in the heart of Liepaja city – a city with long and diverse history, unique architecture and atmosphere, and mostly - wonderful sea and beach.

Studies

The university is divided into four faculties: 1) **Science and Engineering**, 2) **Pedagogy and Social work**, 3) **Humanities and Arts**, and 4) **Management and Social Sciences**.
